



CALL FOR FUNDING PROPOSALS FOR CIVIL SOCIETY PROGRAMMES UNDER THE ALCOHOLIC DRINKS CONTROL ACT, 2010

The National Authority for the Campaign Against Alcohol and Drug Abuse (NACADA) invites proposals for funding under the Alcoholic Drinks Control Fund from locally registered Civil Society Organisations.

The Fund is established under the Alcoholic Drinks Control Act, 2010 Section 5 (1) and draws its receipts mainly from licensing of alcohol selling outlets.

Consideration of funding proposals will be given to interventions that contribute to the objectives of the Alcoholic Drinks Control Act, 2010 and must address any of the following areas:-

- (a) Public education and awareness
- (b) Treatment and rehabilitation including community outreach, residential and non-residential programmes
- (c) Applied Research
- (d) Policy and advocacy
- (e) Specific life skills for youth and children

Funding levels are up to Kshs. 700,000.00 to Civil Society Organizations, Faith Based Organizations and Community Based Organisation's operating in a County. More guidelines and information on the funding is available at the Authority's website www.nacada.go.ke.

Please note that proposals for funding must be submitted as per the stipulated format by **5:00pm on Friday 27th February 2015** to the respective County Governors' offices.
